PATIENT'S RIGHTS

- Right to obtain information from your physician about diagnosis, treatment, and prognosis in language you can understand
- Right to informed consent
- Right to reasonable continuity of care
- Right to be selective, to change doctors, to not settle for a single opinion
- Right to a reasonable amount of time and attention
- Right to the physician's undivided attention during the time allotted to you
- Right to have all costs disclosed to you
- Right to the preservation of personal dignity
- Right to refuse treatment and not to participate in experiments
- Right not to be denied treatment based on race, creed, color, national origin, religion, sex, age, handicap, or source of payment
- Right to inspect, or receive for a reasonable fee, a copy of your medical record
- Right to refuse release of your medical record to any sources except as required because of transfer to another health care facility or as required by law or third party contract
- Right to information about facility rules and regulations affecting patient care and conduct
- Right to have any questions regarding rights and responsibilities addressed by facility personnel
- Right to have pain, if any, managed appropriately
- Right to voice/write a complaint to the Manager

PATIENT'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- A patient is responsible for following the health care facility rules and regulations affecting patient care and conduct
- A patient is responsible for producing a complete and accurate medical history
- A patient is responsible for making it known whether he or she clearly comprehends a contemplated course of action and the things he or she is expected to do
- A patient is responsible for following the recommendations and advice prescribed in a course of treatment by the physician
- A patient is responsible for providing information about unexpected complications that arise in and expected course of treatment
- A patient is responsible for being considerate of the rights of other patients and health facility personnel and property
- A patient is responsible for providing the health facility with accurate and timely information concerning his or her source of payment and ability to meet financial obligations
