The following are disclosed and discussed with me regarding saline implants.

1. It is not permanent
2. It can be deflated
3. It has to be changed
4. It is firmer and harder compared to silicone implants
5. I am aware that the outside covering is made of silicone and it sheds some drops of silicone while in the breast pocket. It is not much as silicone
6. It can cause some allergic reaction
7. It can cause some immunologic disease
8. There may be infection that can occur
9. There is hardening around the implants because scars that form around the implants
10. Deformity can occur due to this hardening
11. Removal of the implants can occur because of infection, hardening, allergic reaction
12. Bleeding and pain can also occur
13. Numbness of the nipples can occur
14. Scars at the armpits, breast folds, around the nipples can become hypertrophic or keloidal (piled up scar)
15. The size of the implants can not be totally matched because of the differences in volume
16. A mastopexy or breast lift may be indicated
17. Additional surgeries may have to be done for aesthetic optimal results
18. Wrinkling deformity in saline implants is most prominent along the inner aspect of the breasts
19. Saline implants may be heavier as compared to silicone
20. I am aware that the manufacturer is offering Insurance Coverage for replacement, surgical materials, operating room expense and anesthesia coverage if deflation occurs (SEE WARRANTY PAMPHLET)
21. I am aware that additional insurance coverage has been offered (SEE WARRANTY PAMPHLET)
22. I have received brochures and information on augmentation mammoplasty
23. All questions are answered by the surgeon and staff to my fullest satisfaction
